Clerk Connolly read a letter from Fellowship House stating they are honored to be a part of Somerset, Appleton and Barker communities and that 1231 individuals have been admitted to Somerset House since they opened on October 20, 1986. They thanked the Board for their support to help these individuals and their families with their recovery from addiction.

SOLAR ENERGY PRESENTATION

EMERALD ASH BORE

J. Hoffman provided information to the Board that he received at a meeting in Lewiston with NYSDEC regarding the breakout of emerald ash bore. He explained the precautions that need to be taken when detected. He said DEC is pessimistic about being able to stop this infestation.

EXTENSION OF NATURAL GAS LINES

J. Hoffman reported on the extension of natural gas lines as addressed in the Comprehensive Plan. He stated that he is having a hard time obtaining a map identifying where the gas lines are in Somerset.

Discussion ensued regarding extending lines and ways to obtain the information.

Chairman Hotaling said he will contact Andrew Reilly from Wendel to see if they have any information. G. Few said he will talk to Paul Ferington, who spearheaded a request for natural gas line extension along Huntington Beach and Lakeview Drive.

Robert Longstreet, representing the Village of Barker Planning Board, reported on the status of the former Birds Eye property, stating the proposed use of a parcel that was sold is not going to happen. He said there is another parcel owned by the Village that is available for purchase.

There being no further business, C. Czelusta moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:12 PM, seconded by N. Jansen. Carried unanimously.
