RE: Police Report for AUGUST 2017

PATROL REPORT

1. Somerset Town Police Officers provided 190 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during August and patrolled approximately 2318 miles.
2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 244 **service calls** were officially logged by TSPD for the month of August.
3. Police Officers submitted Thirty Three (33) Incident Reports, One (1) Domestic Incident Report (DIR), (3) Motor Vehicle Accident Reports (MV104) **and 3 appearance** tickets. A motor Vehicle Stop resulted in the arrest of the driver for the following charges: 2 Cts Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance, 2 Cts of Controlled Substance out of its container, Unlawful Possession of Marihuana, Speeding, Uninspected Motor Veh. and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation.
4. Officers issued Twenty Five (25) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of August. Twenty Three (23) drivers received cautionary warnings.
5. Somerset Police Officers responded to a variety of complaints/incidents/activities during the month of August. They are as follows:

Burglary 1, Larceny 2, Domestic 1, Assist Public 2, Animal Complaint 2, Obstructed Roadway 1, Assist other Agency 4, Illegal Parking 1, Ems/Fire 1, Suspicious Vehicle 1, Harassment 1, Trespass 1, Open Door 1, Unwanted Persons 1, Fire Works 1, Reckless Driver 2, Possession of Drugs 1, Shots Fired 1, Criminal Mischief 1, Found Hypodermic Needle, Fraud Complaint 2, Serve Appearance Tickets 1, Car Accidents 3.
6. Town Police Officers are required to provide house checks as requested by a resident at least once per shift. A number of businesses and municipal buildings are also checked. Officers logged a total of 148 house /business checks during August..
