RE: Police Report for MAY 2017

PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided 180.5 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during May and patrolled approximately 1902 miles.
2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 165 **service calls** were officially logged by TSPD for the month of May.
3. TSPD submitted Twenty four (24) Incident Reports, 1 Motor Vehicle Accident Report (MV104), One (1) warrant (bench/arrest)/ served **zero (0)** Orders of Protection. During the month of May the following **ARREST** were made and presented to the court. 1- DWI, 1- Possession of Marihuana, 1- Unregistered MV, 1- Open alcohol container, 1- Failure to use proper lane, 1- Failure to Keep Right, 1- Assault, 1- Criminal Mischief, 1- Unlawful Imprisonment.
4. TSPD issued Twenty eight (28) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of May. Fourteen (14) drivers received cautionary warnings.
5. TSPD responded to a variety of complaints/incidents/activities during the month of May.

Animal Complaint-2, Larceny-1, Assist other Agency-2, Assault-1, DWI-1, Neighbor Dispute-2, Custody Exchange-1, Domestic-2, Assist Public-1, Car Accident-1, Noise Complain-1, Traffic Complaint-1, Erratic Diver-1, Reckless Driver-2, 911 hang up call-1, Welfare Check-1, Fraud-1.
6. House/Business Checks - TSPD is required to provide house checks as requested by a resident at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 116 house/business checks during the month of May.
