RE: Police Report for June 2021

PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided **211** hours of strategic car patrol coverage during the month of June with **123** hours of SRO coverage to the Barker Central School, **3** hours of court detail and patrolled approximately **2308** miles.
2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. During the month of June **254** service calls were officially logged.
3. TSPD submitted forty-one (**41**) incident reports into the Niagara County's IBR (Incident Based Reporting System). The following is a report breakdown for the month of June:

2-agency assists, 1-larceny, 1-motor vehicle accident, 3-suspicious conditions, 1-unattended death, 4-warrant attempts, 1-missing person, 1-domestic, 1-alarm, 3-welfare checks, 3-juvenile complaints, 3-criminal mischiefs, 1-AUO, 2-disorderly conduct, 4-animal complaints, 8-police service calls, 3-traffic complaint.
Arrests 3 custodial arrests were recorded
4. TSPD issued forty-two (**42**) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of June, two (**2**) vehicles were towed. Twenty-seven (**27**) drivers received cautionary warnings.
5. Property checks- TSPD is required to provide property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged **213** house and business checks were conducted during the month of June.
6. During the month of June Somerset SRO's handled seven (**7**) school related incidents, and held one (**1**) presentations for the students.
