Somerset Police Constables - February Report

PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided 180 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during February and patrolled approximately 2600 miles.

2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community.

190 service calls were officially logged by TSPD for the month of February.

- 3. TSPD submitted Eighteen (18) Incident Reports, zero (0) Domestic Incident Reports (DIR), two (2) Motor Vehicle Accident Reports (MV104A), two (2) appearance tickets and three (3) Arrest Reports during the month of February. There were three (3) misdemeanor/violation and zero (0) felony arrests presented to the court.
- 4. TSPD ticketed fourteen (14) drivers for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, mostly for speeding in reduced speed zones during the month of February. Eleven (11) drivers received cautionary warnings.
- 5. TSPD responded to a variety of complaints/incidents during the month of February.
 - DWI 1; Intoxicated Person/Disorderly Conduct/Unwanted Person 1; Domestic dispute 1; Trespass 1; Neighbor/Property Dispute 1; Criminal Mischief 1; Property/Building Alarm 1; Animal 2; Suspicious Vehicle/Person 5; Check Welfare/Mental Health 3; Juvenile Problem 1; EMS/Fire 1; Marijuana/Non-narcotic possession 1; Att. Burglary 1
- 6. House/Business Checks TSPD is required to provide house checks as requested by a resident at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 141 house/business checks during the month of February.
