Police Report for April 2023

PATROL REPORT

- 1. TSPD provided 203 hours of strategic patrol coverage, and patrolled approximately 1805 miles during the month of April. TSPD officers provided 6 hours of court detail and 112 hours of SRO detail.
- 2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. During the month of April 249 service calls were officially logged.
- 3. TSPD submitted fifty-four (54) incident reports into the Niagara County's IBR (Incident Based Reporting System). The following is a report breakdown for the month of April:
 - 2-agency assists, 2-property crimes, 1-larceny, 6-harassments, 1-trespass, 2-MVA (1-w/injury) 3-suspicious conditions, 1-death investigation, 1-menacing, 1-domestic, 3-alarm 4-welfare checks, 1-juvenile complaint, 1-criminal mischief, 3-AUO arrests, 18-police service calls, 4-traffic complaints.
- 4. TSPD issued twenty-seven (27) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of April, with twenty-two (22) drivers receiving cautionary warnings.
- 5. Property checks-TSPD is required to provide property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 146 house and business checks were conducted during the month of April.

Notable Mention

- *SRO's handled 10 service calls in the Barker School.
- *TSPD participated with other county agencies in DWI enforcement on 4/20 day (3-tickets)
- *Officer Parente completed her FTO training
- *Officer Nick Truax was hired and has began training.
