## PATROL REPORT

- 1. TSPD provided 208 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during January, patrolling approximately 2346 miles. TSPD provided 120 hours of school coverage.
- 2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 299 service calls were officially logged by TSPD for the month of January.
- 3. TSPD submitted twenty-six (26) incident reports into the Niagara County's incident Based reporting system (IBR). The following is a report breakdown of incidents handled for the month of January:

7-agency assists, 4-MVA, 2-suspicious conditions, 1-alarm, 2-welfare checks, 1-juvenile complaint, 1-criminal mischief, 2-AUO arrests, 3-police service, 3-traffic complaints, (1-vehicle towed)

- 4. TSPD issued fifty-two (52) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of January. Thirty-six (36) drivers received cautionary warnings.
- TSPD provides residential property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift in addition there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 273 house and business checks that were conducted during the month of January.
- 7. TSPD SRO's handled 5 juvenile complaints in BCS during the month of January. SRO's also conducted 8 classroom presentations, 2 security sweeps, and investigated 2 suspicious vehicles.

Notable mention:

Vehicle damage to 291 was fixed and the patrol unit being returned to service midmonth.
