Police Report for July 2023

PATROL REPORT

- 1. TSPD provided 199.5 hours of strategic patrol coverage, and patrolled approximately 1961 miles during the month of July. TSPD officers provided 6 hours of court detail and 49 hours of event detail for the town bicentennial.
- 2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. During the month of July 263 service calls were officially logged.
- TSPD submitted sixty-eight (68) incident reports into the Niagara County's IBR (Incident Based Reporting System). The following is a report breakdown for the month of July:
 - 8-agency assists, 3-criminal mischief's, 4-harassments, 2-trespass's, 3-MVA, 7-suspicious conditions, 1-overdose, 4-domestic incidents, 2-alarm 3-welfare checks, 2-juvenile complaints, 1-AUO, 6-animal complaints, 13-police service calls, 6-trafffic complaints, 2-community outreach events.
- 4. TSPD issued thirty-three (33) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of July with eighteen (18) drivers receiving cautionary warnings.
- Property checks- TSPD is required to provide property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 144 house and business checks were conducted during the month of July.

Notable Mention

- *Officer Ashlene Jarmusz was hired by TSPD and will complete her training in August 2023.
- *Unit 290 had service completed and has returned to duty.
- *TSPD members participated active shooter training with the NCSO and other county police agencies
