Police Report for March 2020

PATROL REPORT

- TSPD provided 212 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during March and patrolled 1. approximately 2354 miles.
- All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided 2. Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 300 service calls were officially logged by TSPD for the month of March.
- TSPD submitted thirty (21) incident reports into the Niagara County's incident Based reporting 3. system (IBR). The following is a report breakdown for the month of March:
 - 1-agency assists, 2-larcenys, 2-harassments, 2-trespass, 1-motor vehicle accidents, 1-sex offense, 1-domestic incident, 1-disorderly conduct, 8-police service calls, 2-traffic complaints.
- TSPD issued twenty (20) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month 4. of March. Twenty-two (22) drivers received cautionary warnings.
- TSPD provides residential property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift in 6. addition there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 279 house and business checks that were conducted during the month of March.
- During March the TSPD SRO's handled eleven (8) incidents/student contacts that required police 7. and faculty staff intervention.
