Police Report for May 2021

## PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided 228 hours of strategic car patrol coverage during the month of May with 120 hours of SRO coverage to the Barker Central School and patrolled approximately 2651 miles.

- 2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 223 service calls were officially logged by TSPD for the month of May.
- 3. TSPD submitted forty-three (43) incident reports into the Niagara County's IBR (Incident Based Reporting System). The following is a report breakdown for the month of May:

5-agency assists, 1-property complaint, 1-harassments, 1-trespass, 3-suspicious conditions, 1-fraud investigation, 1-alarm, 2-welfare checks, 2-AUO's, 1-disorderly conduct, 5-animal complaints, 10-police service calls, 10-traffic complaint.

Property 1-set of keys recovered

Arrests 2 custodial arrests were recorded

- 4. TSPD issued forty-five (45) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of May. Thirty-eight (38) drivers received cautionary warnings.
- 6. Property checks- TSPD is required to provide property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 180 house and business checks were conducted during the month of May.
- 7. During the month of May Somerset SRO's handled four (4) school related incidents, and held three (3) presentations for the students.

Notable Mention: Officer Micale was hired to supplement the SRO program and has began her final phase of training at Niagara University. Two DWI details were conducted in conjunction with the NCSO and NYSP Patrols. A fraud presentation was presented at the Barker Fire hall for area seniors.
