Police Report for October 2020

PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided 211.5 hours of strategic patrol coverage each night during October, patrolling approximately 2272 miles. SRO's provided 144 hours of school coverage.

- 2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. 196 service calls were officially logged by TSPD for the month of October.
- 3. TSPD submitted thirty-one (31) incident reports into the Niagara County's incident Based reporting system (IBR). The following is a report breakdown of incidents handled for the month of October:

8-agency assists, 2-larceny's, 2-harassments, 1-MVA, 2-suspicious conditions, 1-domestic,1-welfare check, 1-DWI, 1-AUO, 1-noise complaints, 3-animal complaint, 6-police service, 2-traffic complaints (1-vehicles towed)

- 4. TSPD issued fifty-three (53) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of October. Twenty-three (23) drivers received cautionary warnings.
- 6. TSPD provides residential property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift in addition there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged 165 house and business checks that were conducted during the month of October.
- 7. TSPD SRO's handled 3-juvenile complaints in BCS and initiated 4-emergency drills to satisfy NYS school safety requirements during the month of October.

Notable mention:

TSPD hired a new patrol new patrolman. Officer Nick Thomas. He will be starting his Field Training in November. Annual firearms qualifications were completed with all members qualifying with both pistol and patrol rifles.
