RE: Police Report for March 2022

PATROL REPORT

1. TSPD provided **205** hours of strategic patrol coverage, and patrolled approximately **1996** miles during the month of March. School Resource officers provided **184** hours of coverage to the Barker Central School.
2. All service calls are logged and recorded in the Niagara County Sheriff's E-911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, including house/business checks and vehicle stops. This accountability mechanism is vitally important to assess the effectiveness of the agency and the overall service needs of our community. During the month of March **316** service calls were officially logged.
3. TSPD submitted forty (**40**) incident reports into the Niagara County's IBR (Incident Based Reporting System). The following is a report breakdown for the month of March:

7-agency assists, 1-larceny, 1-burglary, 4-motor vehicle accidents 3-suspicious conditions, 1-alarm, 2-welfare checks, 1-DWI, 1-AUO, 2-animal complaint, 13-police service calls, 4-traffic complaints
4. TSPD issued forty-two (**42**) citations for violations of the Vehicle and Traffic Law during the month of March, with twenty-five (**25**) drivers receiving cautionary warnings.
5. Property checks- TSPD is required to provide property checks as requested by residents at least one time per shift and there are also a number of business/municipal buildings which are required to be inspected. TSPD logged **209** house and business checks were conducted during the month of March.

Notable Mention

- *On 03/06/2022 supplemental dayshift coverage for the Olcott Polar Plunge produced 7 tickets and a AUO arrest.
- *TSPD participated in a county wide St. Patrick's Day DWI sweep making one DWI arrest and 3 additional tickets.
- *Officer Micale tendered her resignation from the TSPD effective 03/31/2022.
